- a. What is Gilligan's (1982) gender-related ethical theory? [4 marks]b. How useful are her ideas in understanding business or professional ethics? [6 marks]
- 5. Describe two of the major meta-ethical theories, using one example from professional or business ethics for each.  $[2 \times 5 = 10 \text{ marks}]$
- 6. How can you as a manager or supervisor increase your team's moral awareness? Discuss two strategies by giving one example from professional or business ethics. [2 × 5 = 10 marks]
