Question 5

The internet has opened up possibilities for faster feedback and more effective crisis management. However, the internet also carries risks. Explain **FIVE (5)** risks of using new media as a crisis management tool. (10 marks)

Question 6

Identifying the key publics is an important element of a crisis management plan. Explain FOUR (4) groups of publics. Provide an example for each group. (8 marks)

Question 7

On 24th March, 1989 Exxon Valdez Oil Spill became one of the world's most devastating human-caused environmental disaster. Explain **FIVE (5)** errors Exxon had done in handling the crisis. (10 marks)

Question 8

You are the Corporate Affairs Manager at ABC International School. On 18 February 2019, at 2.30PM, a fire broke out at the East Block of the school and 4 students were injured. The fire had been successfully extinguished after 10 minutes. Write a holding statement to indicate to the media that you are taking the crisis seriously. Include **THREE (3)** actions that had been taken by your school.
