

# Question 2

Read the question below and answer the questions that follow.

Mary and Cindy work in the same department in a multi-national company (MNC) in Kuala Lumpur and report to Dr. Johnson. Mary and Cindy are co-workers and have been working together in the same department for the past 5 years. Due to their close relationship, they get along very well during and after working hours. Both of them share the same interests at work and they plan their career path together.

However, last week Mary noticed that Cindy was called by Dr. Johnson several times and she later heard from another colleague, Mandy, that Cindy has been selected to represent the organization in one of the conferences in Istanbul. According to Mandy, "Cindy will be picked by Dr. Johnson to Istanbul because she is young, fair and from the same hometown as Dr. Johnson."

Then Mary remembers an incident from 2 years ago when Cindy was called by Dr. Johnson and later, everyone found out that she was sent to Sweden to attend an international conference. Mary is feeling devastated whenever she thinks about it as she was hoping to be selected. Mary is thinking that Cindy has been going behind her back to seek permission to attend the conferences from Dr. Johnson. Mary now is avoiding Cindy and this has created a not-so-harmonious working atmosphere in the office.

Yesterday, Mary was called to Dr. Johnson office and he handed her an invitation letter to the conference in Istanbul. Mary is elated but she is also confused at the same time.

She said this Dr. Johnson;

"I am more than happy to attend the conference but I was told that you have picked Cindy to represent the company"

- (c) Provide FOUR (4) arguments why you think the language used is biased or sexist.
