Question 3

Due to uncertain environment characterized by time pressures, increasing workloads, mergers and restructuring, a large number of employees are overworked and stressed. A study found that stress is the leading cause of people quitting their jobs. Further studies indicate that setting the right goals can help motivate employees and significantly reduce work related stress, and employee burnout.

Motivation is a tool used by organisations to encourage their employees to work towards the common goals. Different groups of employees need different types of motivation. There are available theories regarding this such as Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs, McGregor's Theory X and Theory Y, Herzberg's Two Factor Theory, and Reinforcement Theory.
