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1. (a) State the difference between unilateral and bilateral contract. (5 marks)

3. (a) State five (5) essential elements to form a valid contract. (15 marks)
4. (a) State the various types of goods covered by the Hire-Purchase Act 1967. (8 marks)
- (b) Describe briefly what is a "hire-purchase agreement." (7 marks)
