Hani holds a single ticket from Penang to London with a transit in Kuala Lumpur with ABC Airline. Her flight from Penang to Kuala Lumpur was delayed for 3 hours. As a result of that, she would miss her connecting flight to London.

Travellers have an expectation to receive their bags as soon as they land. If your baggage does not arrive on the same flight as you, or is lost or damaged during the flight, you may be entitled to compensation for the inconvenience caused.

Scenario A

Lopez did not purchase any travel insurance when she made a booking with ABC Airline to fly to Kota Kinabalu. Upon her arrival in Kota Kinabalu, she realised that her baggage did not arrive and she lodged a report with ABC Airline at the airport.

Outline the options available to Lopez in relation to her entitlement for compensation from ABC Airline?
