INSTRUCTION(S) : Answer **ALL SIX (6)** questions.

1. The three types of noise show how noise, as a technical term, contributes to the functions of human communication. Identify the **THREE (3)** types and explain them adequately. Illustrate your explanation with one specific example for each type. (12 marks)

- 2. Perception plays an important part in the functions of human communication. Our perception is affected by four types of selective activities. Explain the **FOUR (4)** types of selectivity. Provide **ONE (1)** example for each type. (10 marks)
- 3. Explain the **FOUR (4)** types of listening.

- 4. Creating the right group climate is important to the cohesiveness of a small group. Explain the **THREE (3)** factors that contribute to group climate. Also, name and explain the unintended, negative outcome of group cohesiveness. (12 marks)
- 5. Explain the Sapir-Whorf hypothesis. Why do some people have problems with the hypothesis? Explain **ONE (1)** reason. (8 marks)
- 6. Nonverbal communication includes the use of space. Explain the **TWO (2)** concepts considered to be essential to the study of space. Give **ONE (1)** example for each concept (10 marks)

- 1. Intercultural communication is a major element of human communication. Answer (a), (b) and (c) below on intercultural communication. (20 marks)
 - (a) Explain intercultural communication.
 - (b) Discuss **THREE (3)** intercultural problems, using specific examples to illustrate.
 - (c) Explain co-culture and give **ONE (1)** example. Also, discuss the **THREE (3)** ways a co-culture engages or responds to the dominant culture.
- 2. Provide an example for **interpersonal communication** and for **mass communication**. Then, discuss their differences in terms of **sender**, **channel**, and **feedback**. Use specific examples to make clear your explanation. (20 marks)
