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### Question 1

- b) Based on the branch's organizational design, describe **FOUR (4)** elements of organizational design. (8 marks)
- c) Evaluate **FOUR (4)** reasons why Mr. Robert should engage in planning for the branch. (16 marks)

That is why she is taking control actions to ensure that employees are working efficiently and effectively to provide that service. - c) If the employees resist to change, Evaluate **FOUR (4)** techniques she can use to overcome it. (16 marks)
